MR. SANTEN: We're assuming something occurred somehow with that water break on Michigan Avenue there. The day that it happened there was some sort of surge or something in the system, pressure surge.

MR. LOPEZ: Your note said operator error.

MR. HERRERA: No. That was for the Past Due.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: Ray Lopez, this is Allegretti. I read that question too in my e-mail back to Ed. And that was reproduced I saw and put in the packet.

There is no identity of anybody that did anything. I think Ed was making -- go ahead.

MR. SANTEN: No. It was basically my observation that the water operator in my perspective. I don't know who did it or if anyone did anything.

MR. LOPEZ: Okay. Well, thank you, Eddy, for bringing attention to it because that's a big amount. At least you're on top of it. Thank you.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: Let me just say that Ed has been spending a lot of resources and energy in identifying and eliminating pressure surges which I think conventional wisdom is contribute to an opportunity for main brakes.

MR. LOPEZ: Okay, Joe. Thank you.

MR. HERRERA: It's in Winna's packet. I didn't list it on the agenda. However it was listed on Winna's agenda. If you look inside of her report, you'll see that it's in there. And if Ed wants to elaborate on it if anybody has any questions.

MR. SANTEN: Yes. The City owns a valve turning piece of equipment that must have been purchased quite sometime ago. It's hydraulically operated.

So the invoice that you have there is to make the hydraulic units electrical operated and also purchase another unit for Distribution. So Filtration has one operation of valve turner and the Distribution side would have one operation valve turner electrical.

And the main reason you need that is some of these valves are, believe it or not, almost 300 turns or more, the bigger ones. But it's safer to do that for the employees to not ruin their backs. And I recommend that you purchase that equipment for this valve.

MR. LOPEZ: What was the invoice?

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MR. SANTEN: The total amount I don't have it in front of me.

MR. VENTURA: The total amount is \$10,180.

MR. LOPEZ: I don't have any information. So was that an emergency?

MR. EL HARIT: I do agree with Ed. We do need this equipment. I mean like for example like he said 300 turns to 500 turns. So I recommend that we get it.

MR. SANTEN: We need the equipment. I am not sure emergency. But if we don't have it we can't operate the system. So I'm not sure how I could answer that.

MR. LOPEZ: I suggest at the next meeting you send us a copy of the invoice because I don't have anything in front of me.

MR. SANTEN: I gave that to Winna. But I will make sure I give you all the information. That's not problem.

MR. HERRERA: Raymond, it's inside of Winna's packet. Look inside of Winna's. It's in there.

MR. SANTEN: Okay. Good. That's the background then.

MR. LOPEZ: It's not in my pocket. In my packet I've got 37 blank sheets. Somebody made a mistake or double copied. I don't know. But I have 37 blank sheets. And I checked every one of them. I don't have that one.

MR. HERRERA: It's the last item.
