Safety Security Light Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to provide a safety security light to the residents of the City of East Chicago. The City, through the **Operation Light It Up** Program, will purchase the initial labor and materials. The property owner must maintain and pay operating costs of the individual security light on private property. Currently, we will be installing **Dusk to Dawn Safety Security Lights**. The light operates with electricity. It does contain a photocell which detects the light. It shuts the light off when the sun rises and turns the light on when the sun sets.

The parties to this agreement of the City of East Chicago Operation Light It Up Program (hereinafter referred to as the ECLP) are the Engineering Department, a property owner, (Hereinafter referred to as recipient), and the said electrical contractor installer. Any resident of the City of East Chicago who owns and occupies their home, who presents a need to have a security light installed on his or her premises by the Light It Up Program, must have the aforementioned completed.

PLEASE READ the terms of the agreement below.

1. Must be an East Chicago owner/occupied residential homeowner, proof of ownership and show a current Driver's License or State Identification.
2. Only the ECLP will be entitled to receive any manufacturer's rebate and / or any NIPSCO rebate applicable to said security light purchased and installed.
3. A contracted certified electrician acting as an agent of the ECLP will be the only one allowed to make the installation of the security light for warranty purposes.
4. The City of East Chicago Electrical Inspector may inspect and certify the installation of the security light.
5. Only one (1) security light per household may be installed for the life of property ownership.
6. The recipient agrees to maintain the security light. The light is under warranty for one (1) year. Once the security light warranty has expired, the recipient will be responsible for any necessary repairs including bulb replacement, photocells, or other parts needed.
7. The recipient will pay all electrical bills for the operation of said security light.
8. The recipient is **prohibited** from moving or removing said security light without prior written approval from the ECLP and general permission will be granted only to move said security light from one location of the property to a more suitable location on said property by a certified electrician, who will

be responsible for wiring of the light and which limits the warranty to certain parts only. Warranty does not include removal of fixture unless fixture or wiring is faulty.

9. Once installed, security light will remain a permanent fixture of the property on which it has been installed.
10. The recipient is prohibited from selling said security light; taking it with them if they relocate or from otherwise disposing of said light.
11. The recipient agrees to hold the ECLP and its agents harmless from any and all liability claimed from or liability resulting from installation, existence or operation of said security light.
12. All correspondence for security light repairs and concerns should be directed first to the City Engineer to check on warranty status and to document the call, then to the electrical contractor who installed said security light. The homeowner will be responsible for any additional charges accrued after installation if not covered by warranty.
13. **Warranty is for one (1) year ONLY** after installation. Warranty covers parts and labor for repair of faulty fixture or wiring. After the one (1) year warranty has expired, the recipient is 100% responsible for the light.
14. **THIS APPLICATION DOES NOT GUARANTEE QUALIFICATION FOR THE LIGHT AS SUPPLY IS LIMITED.**
15. The light **MUST** be installed by **August 31, 2020** or the recipient will forfeit their qualification for the security light.

 - a. Original and copy of homestead exemption.
 - b. Original and copy of utility bill (water, NIPSCO, or cable)
3. Provide a valid driver's license or state ID.
4. Applications and required documents must be **COMPLETED** and submitted in its **ENTIRETY**.
