another entity. We're working on that. I sent the information over to Law Department and just waiting for a response.

MR. LOPEZ: I know some of these are small debts:

MR. LOPEZ: But if you add them all up, that's a pretty good amount.

MS. GUZMAN: For sure.

I have a question. US Gypsum is one of MR. BAKOTA: them.

MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

MR. BAKOTA: They're still an active company in our City.

And that one I believe there's an MS. GUZMAN: Yes. There was an error on the billing. And I believe I that brought that up.

MR. BAKOTA: Because it shows bad debt.

MS. GUZMAN: Yeah. And in the future I'll be giving a little bit more description on it. It's just when the staff pulls it up they do give me the records. But they just put bad debt on there. But I'll be more specific in the future.

MR. VENTURA: Next on the agenda we have Report from Legal Counsel, Attorney Joseph Allegretti.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: Briefly at the last Council Meeting the Council approved a rollover of our \$2 million debt which remains unpaid.

It was kind of an emergency infusion of cash we got from the City's General Fund. I think Winna knows the detail much better than I do. But some emergency repairs, some water main breaks.

The obvious question of course was when are you going to pay it back. And the answer was we don't know.

We weren't specifically asking for the debt to be forgiven.

I did inform them that we are undergoing a tentative Cost of Service Study in anticipation of filing a rate case with the IURC. That's the Indiana Utility Regulatory commission.

We're nearing completion. And I've been saying this for awhile. But actually I think we are closing in on a file date.

We'll be having a work study session with our cost of service provider to explain what our financial situation is with the Board and what the recommended revenue needs are for the Utility for us to be able to pay our bills and make our repairs.

As I said earlier Winna has been acting as the De Facto Superintendent of the Waterworks Department working nonstop and doing a wonderful job.

I don't want to embarrass, Winna. But you have been. It's one crisis after another.

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Today Winna and yesterday was talking about we're having a threatened shortage on needed necessary chemicals for our treatment process.

These shortages are common not only I guess in the chemical industry just like they are in the automobile industry and in the chip industry and having Winna scrambling around and getting backup sources from suppliers and vendors for these things.

Lastly and Winna is better to talk about this than I am. We still haven't filled the job of superintendent. There is a plan on promoting Obet, Jr.

MS. GUZMAN: Jr., yes.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: To the job. He is highly qualified. Has a technical degree and lots of experience, young and energetic.

And that's probably going to be the subject of a motion or a resolution maybe a formal report maybe at the next meeting. But that's the plan. And that's exciting.

But still the superintendent position has not been filled. The search goes on.

MR. BAKOTA: The hope is he's going to be Distribution Supervisor.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: He's going to be more, no, Operations.

MR. BAKOTA: But Ed was Distribution Supervisor.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: Right. Kind of, yeah. I think the most, the biggest need I think is in Operations. And Winna is better qualified to answer that question than I am. But that's my understanding.

But the place is running. Still producing good water. And all we need is a little more revenue and a few more people. We are undermanned and are searching for qualified employees.

MR. BAKOTA: Did we get any feedback from that company we hired as a lead detection for unaccounted for water?

MR. ALLEGRETTI: There was an extensive amount of significant leaks that have been identified and repaired.

And again Winna is better qualified to talk about that.

MS. GUZMAN: I can provide a report on that.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: But it was a significant amount. I don't know what the amount of water was. But I think it was in excess of a million gallons a day.

MS. GUZMAN: Yes

MR. ALLEGRETTI: We were losing through these leaks. My understanding is that 95 percent of those leaks have been repaired.

MS. GUZMAN: Yes. I would say yes. There's just a few and they're on the private side.

MR. BAKOTA: And that study is still going on, right?

MS. GUZMAN: Well, we are going to be extending it to actually the Marktown area. We just approved that. So we're going to find out exactly when they're there going to commence that work so we can continue our efforts.

And for next year I believe I have the proposal for that. So I will be making sure that we have the funding to cover those expenses.

MR. BAKOTA: And also we get the Fire Report which is quite a bit of water. That surprised me the amount of water.

MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: It's an eye opener.

MS. GUZMAN: And I'm also asking Sanitary as well to provide a report.

MR. BAKOTA: On usage?

MS. GUZMAN: Yes. Usage report, yes.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: I will just say one more operational comment. These are things again as the lawyer I am not qualified to really discuss operations. But they're are ongoing.

We have Christopher Burke Engineering and we have Austgen Electric collaborating on some potential future

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capital projects among which are some design improvements or replacement of the Water, Chicago Avenue Water Tower. It's not functioning as it should be. Needs some modification or repairs or perhaps even replacement.

And the Mayor is working on appropriating some of the rescue funds. The City received its first \$15 million in rescue funds which is half of the \$32 million the City is eligible for and qualified to receive.

The major uses of those kinds of funds is infrastructure, water and sanitary. And Winna and staff is trying to make sure that the Water Utility has its hand out at the appropriate time and gets its appropriate share of those moneys for needed capital improvements.

And I will stop talking. Any additional questions on those subjects should be addressed to Winna.

MR. OCHOA: Is there a shelf life for these water treatment chemicals?

MS. GUZMAN: I believe that's one of the questions that we brought up. So I will be getting that information in the next couple of days. And that's something that we talked about today.

And I just want to add that in our efforts to try to fill some of these open positions I have forwarded to various entities, contractors, plumbing contractors, subcontractors, general contractors the open positions for the Water Department. That includes Distribution, Filtration.

So I have submitted. I received the list from the Building Department. I forwarded, I e-mailed all the job openings to the various contractors.

And I also sent out the same job openings to various individuals within Lake County. I received a list from IDEM.

And they are licensed operators. They hold licenses and they are listed under IDEM. They provided me that list. And I did forward them a list of the open positions, the job openings in hopes that we can get someone to come forward and fill some of these positions.

MR. LOPEZ: Question, Joe.

MR. ALLEGRETTI: Yes, sir. 1 MR. LOPEZ: On these funds that are coming in, these 2 moneys, more is going to be coming once they pass that other bill. Who makes the decision in the City where the money 3 qoes? 4 MR. ALLEGRETTI: They are in the form of additional appropriations. The statutory process is that an additional 5 appropriation occurs upon the recommendation of the Executive, the Mayor, and approved by Ordinance, adopted by 6 Common Council. So it has to be a cooperative collaborative effort which sometimes that's not always easy as we all know. 8 9 MR. LOPEZ: There's going to be a lot of money coming in. Thank you. 10 MR. VENTURA: Any other questions for Attorney 11 Allegretti? 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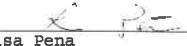
