MR. GOMEZ: First item on our agenda is from Lot O Fun from Schererville. It's for two covers for an F-250 truck bed, french doors, standard side door, both sides with bins.

The amount for both is \$5,600. \$2,700 each \$5,400. \$200 for labor and service which will be a total of \$5,600.

These are for the Water Department. And the reason it is before the Board of Works is because the funding source is the Seed Account which is our County Economic Development Income Tax Fund.

MR. POWERS: It's actually \$2,800 each, correct?

MR. GOMEZ: \$5,600. It's \$5,400 for the cover and \$200 for the labor. So \$5,600.

And we do have an e-mail from Smith Motors where they inform the Water Department that they cannot bill the '21 or '22 model. I think that's about it.

The only comment I wish to make is we've been seeing this issue since the pandemic where car dealerships have a problem receiving stock or keeping stock. So it's imperative to try to purchase these vehicles where you can find them.

So that's the problem we've had not only with these, but other vehicles.

MR. GOMEZ: So request the Water Department to do a corresponding action where they acknowledge our action here.

We'll move on. The next item on our agenda is from Gerber Chevy. This is for 2022 Chevy Equinox. This is for 14 of these vehicles. The request is from Public Works. Gerber's price for 14 units is \$25,000 per unit. 14 units equals \$350,000.

They have included in their paperwork two rejections from other dealerships. And it's for the reason I had mentioned before where we have from Phillips Chevrolet, they don't have the inventory.

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And also from, let's see, Smith Chevrolet of Hammond. Also unfortunately at this time we cannot fulfill an order for 14 Equinox.

So it's the same issue where the dealerships have trouble keeping stock or receiving the vehicles.

These 14 vehicles I believe they're going to be used for various departments.

MR. CID: That's correct. Rene Cid, East Chicago Public Works Director.

Yes. We're asking for approval of the purchase of 14 Equinox. These vehicles are going throughout the City of East Chicago, various departments.

Also in that package deal there we're receiving like a \$2,000 discount from regular price for government discount.

MR. GOMEZ: Thank you. It does say here there is a government discount price. We have a lot of paperwork for these vehicles.

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
